Executive reception, hospitality lounges, higher education environments, and residential applications.

One Liner

Originally conceived as a lounge concept for the Genel Residence by Kahn in 1972. The sketches included a repeating leg structure that suggested a modular system which IKONstudio used to develop a complete lounge family with a distinctive architectural rhythm.

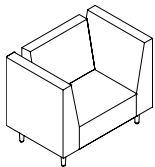
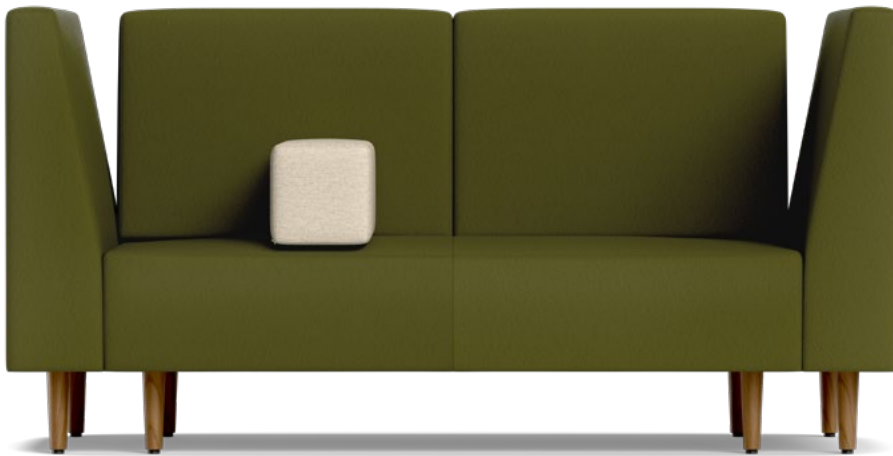
Louis Kahn Collection

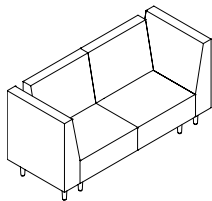

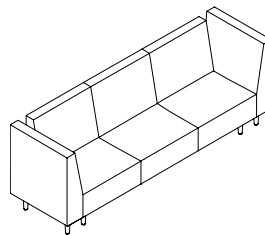

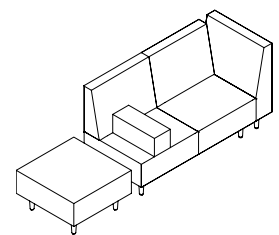
Sofa Chair



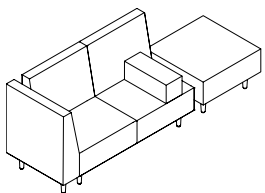
Lounge, Two-Seater



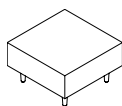
Lounge, Three-Seater
