IKONstudio's Design Approach

- Interpreted multiple archival sketch iterations into a single table design
- Preserved the original architectural character while refining proportions for scalable manufacturing
- Replaced the originally drawn drawers with open cubbies
- Added integrated power and cable management
- Leveraged Solutions woodwork craftsmanship to create richly detailed veneer expressions, including carefully matched grain patterns and refined waterfall transitions

Executive offices and conference rooms, community tables, dining spaces, and higher education environments.

A wood table concept originally developed by Kahn for the Radbill Oil Company executive interiors and brought to life by our Solutions woodwork manufacturing team. The design reflects Kahn's belief that furniture and architecture should be conceived as one integrated system.

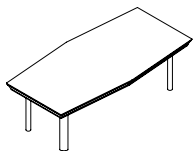
Louis Kahn Collection

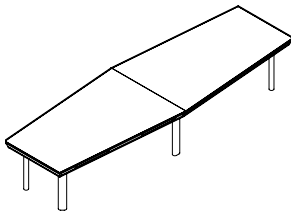

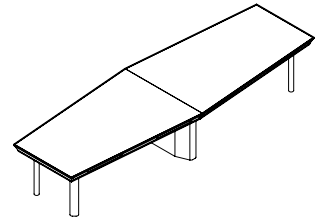
