IKONstudio's Design Approach

- Interpreted archival sketches into a fully resolved table collection.
- Used modern engineering to scale the design into larger conference and community table sizes while preserving the signature thin-leg profile.
- Developed a distinctive picture-frame top that showcases IKONstudio's advanced wood craftsmanship and carefully matched veneer patterns.
- Integrated power and electrical options to support contemporary workplace needs.
- Refined proportions and construction for repeatable manufacturing and long-term performance.

Executive offices, meeting spaces, community tables, and dining areas.

Originally sketched by Kahn for the Weiss Residence and reimaged by IKONstudio as a refined architectural table that combines slender proportions, exceptional wood craftsmanship, and integrated technology. The design demonstrates Kahn's ability to create quiet elegance through proportion, detail, and structural clarity.

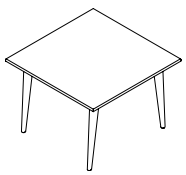
Louis Kahn Collection

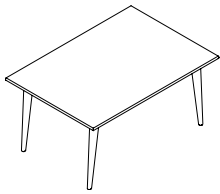


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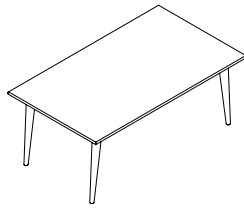
