blink chair

Designed in partnership with Formway, Blink delivers intuitive comfort and support without multiple mechanisms. Blink re-envisioned the ubiquitous plastic chair, elevates the expected aesthetics, innovates ergonomics, and prioritizes sustainable design. Blink's hidden intelligence focuses on movement, not manual adjustments. Inspired by auxetic structures, Blink's patent-pending shell is precision-molded in a unique pattern

of varying cuts, depths, and spacing, allowing it to stretch and contract with the body's movements and creating targeted flex. The patent-pending Keel Mechanism provides solid grounding and immediate responsiveness as your body moves. Blink features 73.45% recycled content. By using materials such as regenerated nylon and recycled polypropylene, the carbon content is reduced by 30%—not what you'd expect from a plastic chair.


kiosk planters


