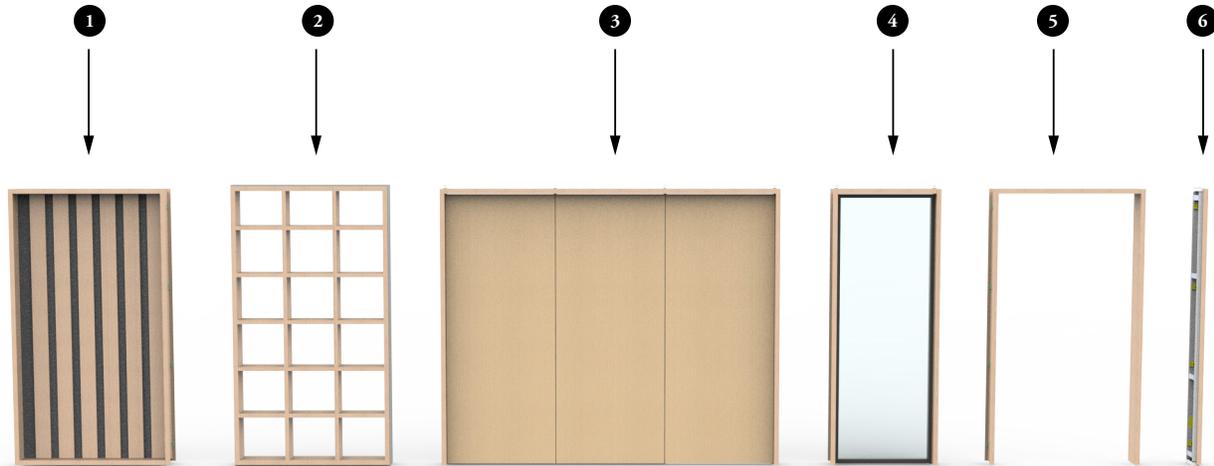

Ligna is made of various module and end trims, the following is an overview of the main components.



- 1 Louver**
 - Provides adaptable privacy and adjusts light condition within a space
- 2 Bookshelf**
 - Provides functional shelves while serving as a space divider
- 3 Wall**
 - Divides space while providing visual privacy
- 4 Glass**
 - Divides space while maintaining transparency
- 5 Pass-Through**
 - Provides an access pathway between spaces
- 6 End Trim**
 - Finishes a Ligna run start/ends

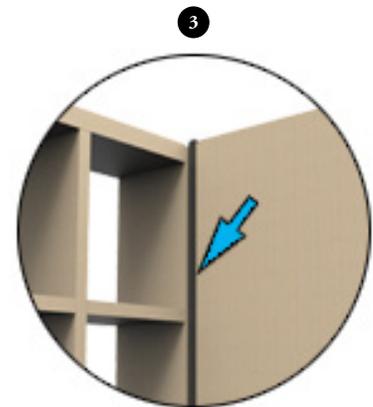
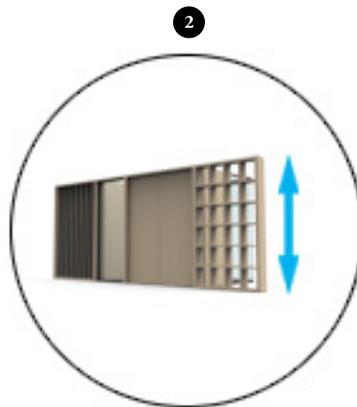
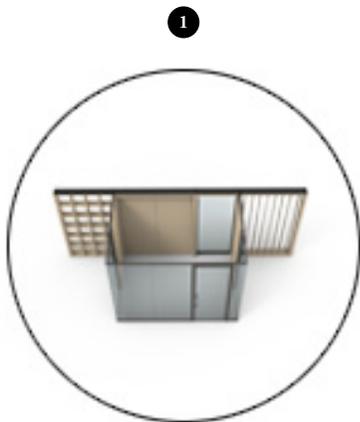
what is ligna

office placement

Ligna is a flexible system, the application of which can be understood in three basic principles.



- 1 Stand alone**
 - Linear straight runs only and Ligna does not attach to any building walls
- 2 Floor to Ceiling**
 - 96"-120" and must be attached to both the floor and ceiling
- 3 Interface with Walls**
 - Altos, Optos, Tek Vue and Focus can be connected between modules

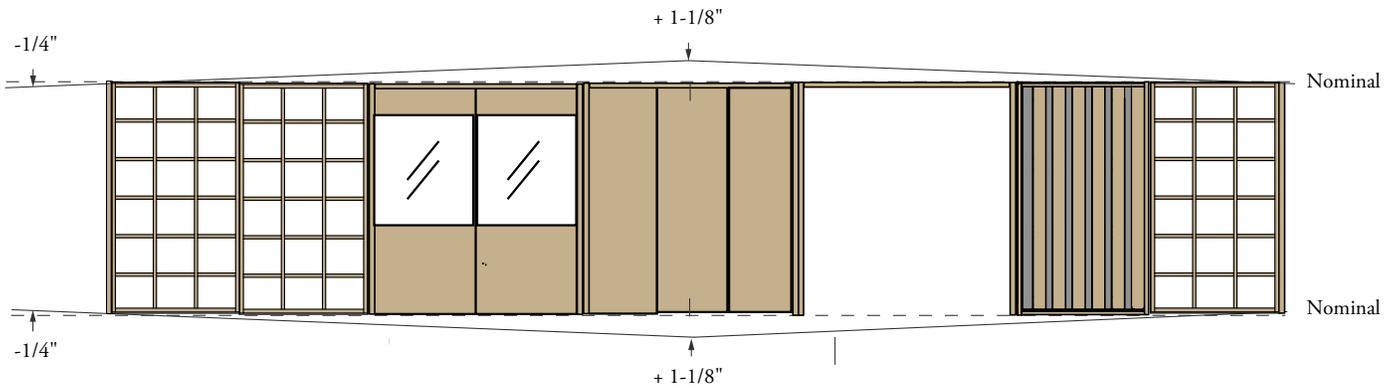

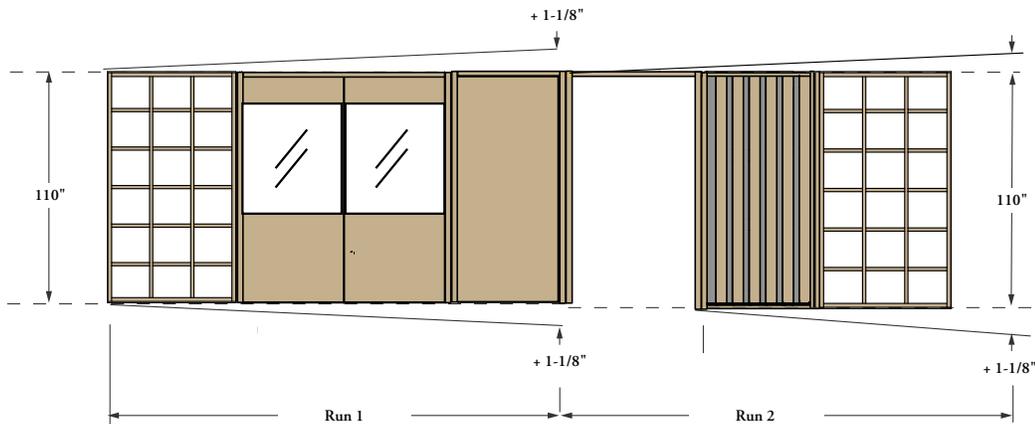
office placement (continued)

When creating a Ligna layouts the following site conditions should be considered.

The maximum leveling range is $+1-1/8"$ and $-1/4"$ at the floor and ceiling. (* limited to $+3/4"$ at the ceiling for the louvers and pass-through modules).



If floor is unlevel greater than $1-1/8"$ in a Ligna run a 1" taller or shorter modules can be used in a new adjacent run using either a pass-through module or alternatively a new run can be started.



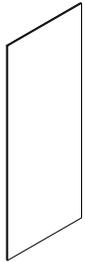

The frame components are used in conjunction with the various fascia options. Frame components are determined by the fascias elevations chosen and the specific configuration on the inside and outside of the wall module.



- For each Wall Module requires:
- 1 x Ceiling Frame Kit (LNSHP)
 - Refer to Vertical Posts (LNSVP) and Horizontal Kits (LNFHP) section for quantities

The selected fascias will determine the Vertical Post and the Fascia Horizontal Kits.
Each fascia elevation within a module can be configured with a Monolithic or Working Wall, front and back.

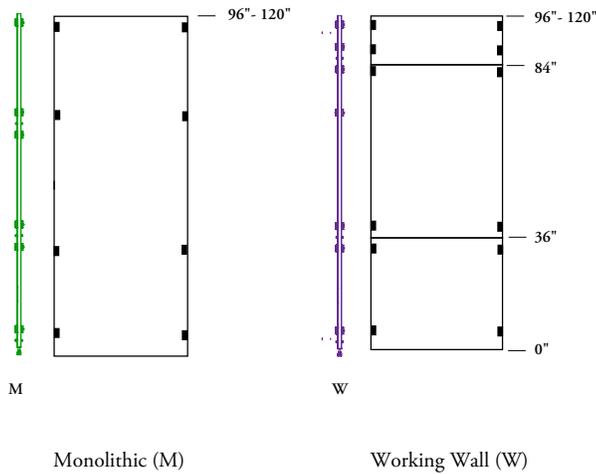

The columns space between the dividers is equally spaced which is determined by the module width. See the examples below:



Bookshelf is available in Flintwood, Standard and Cathedral.



Adjustable Shelves:
Shelf peg holes are spaced 1.25" (32mm) O.C for a total of +/- 3.75" from the nominal position.



Fixed Shelves:
Shelves are fixed and no holes or adjustment is included.

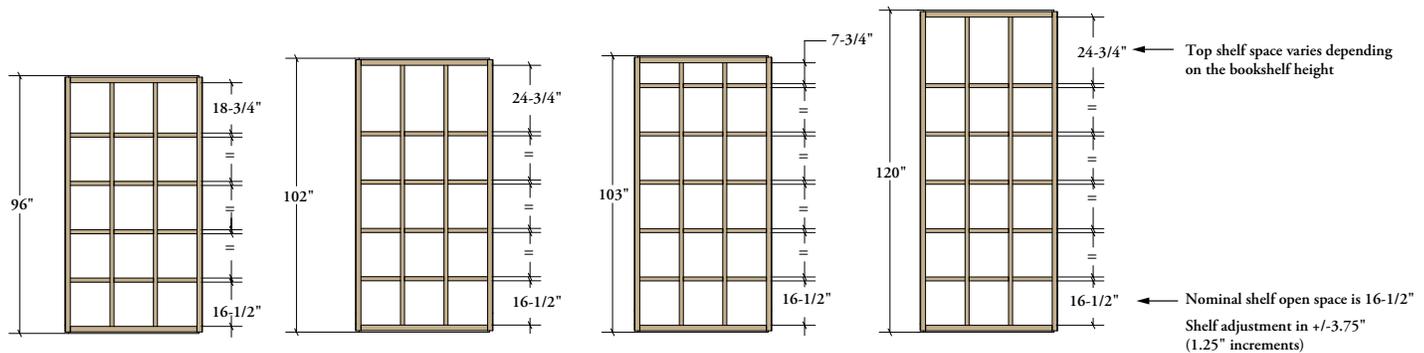

Each Ligna run will require the following:

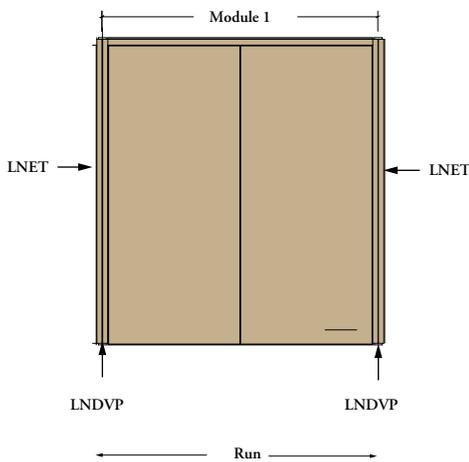
- 2x End Trims (LNET)
Always at the beginning and end of a Ligna run regardless on the number of modules used.
- 2x or more Double Vertical Post (LNDVP)
Always at the beginning and end of every module, two adjacent module share the same double post.
- Height is determined by the adjacent module height for both the Double Post (LNDVP) and the End Trim (LNET)

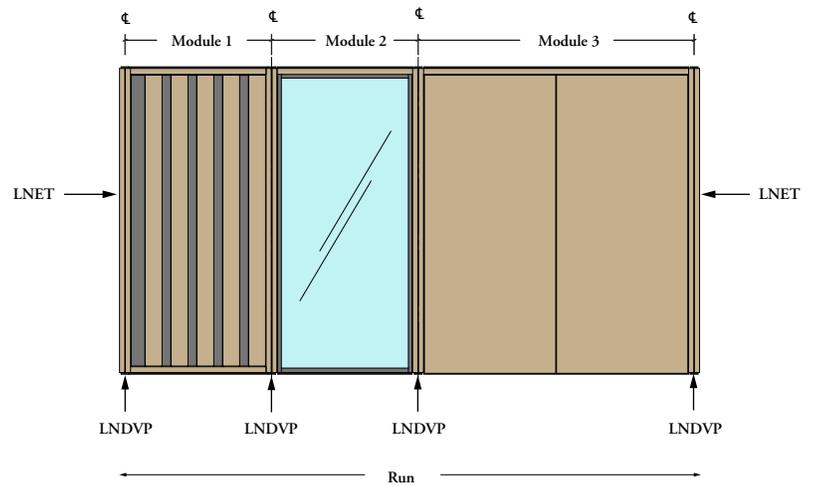

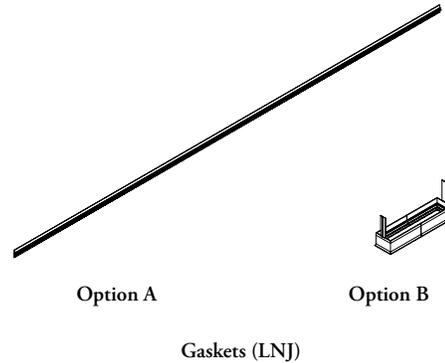

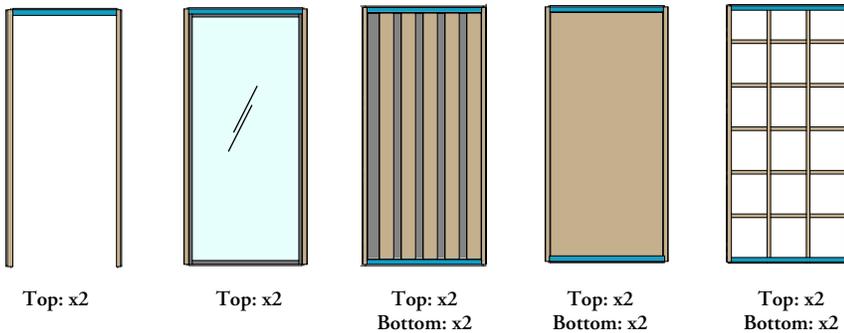
The Ligna includes the following universal parts.

Each Ligna run will require gaskets.

- There are two types:
 - Base/Ceiling Gasket - Options A
 - Double Post Gasket - Options B
- Up to 2x Double Post Gaskets (1x top and 1x bottom) are required for each 1x Double Vertical Post (LNDVP)
- Base/Ceiling Gasket includes 1x 120" length and is cut on site and is required in the following location for each module, see below:



The following show where the Base/Ceiling Gasket - Options A is required and how many. (x2 = 2x module width).



See the following examples:

Formula - Gasket - Base/Ceiling - Option A:

Total Quantity Required*:

$$(\text{Module 1 Width} \times 4) + (\text{Module 2 Width} \times 2) / 120 \text{ rounded up to next whole number} + (\text{Module 3 Width} \times 4) / 120 \text{ rounded up to next whole number} = \text{Total}$$

* Calculation is used for each run of Ligna, calculation should be done in subsections when a pass-through or glass module is included

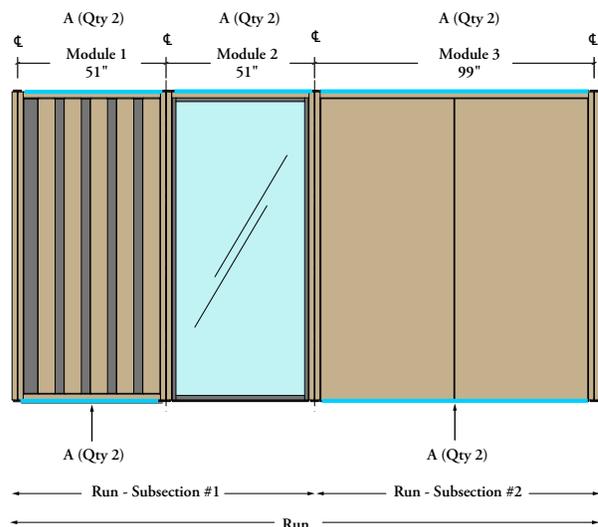

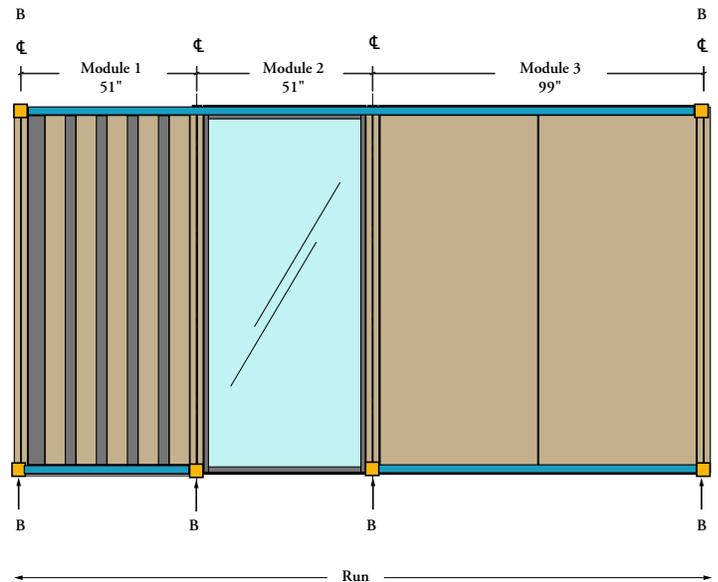

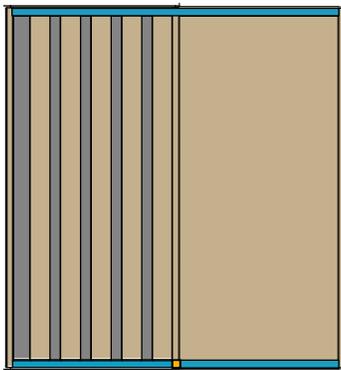

(Qty 4 total for run)

No additional Gasket - Option B (LNJB) required between module at the top

Ceiling Hardware (LNCH)

Each Ligna run will require ceiling attachment and has two types available for the Ceiling Hardware (LNCH)

- Option U - Universal bracket for drywall, concrete ceilings
- Option T - 15/16" T-Track

Some module horizontal kits require additional hardware to be attached to the ceiling.

The number of brackets required is dependent on the type of module selected and its width, see below:

Wall	Qty 2 (18"-99") -3 (102"-144")	(Universal bracket or T-Track option)
Glass	Qty 2 (18"-72")	(Universal bracket or T-Track option)
Bookshelf	Qty 2 (51"-69")	(Universal bracket or T-Track option)

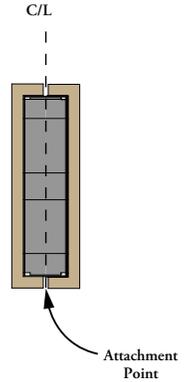
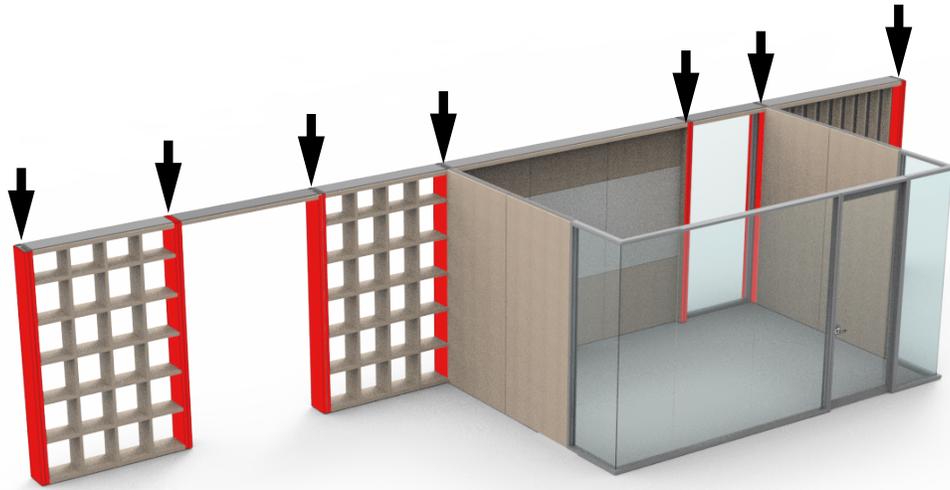
Louver and pass-through modules horizontal kits are used for attachment to ceiling - no additional ceiling hardware required
